TURNING ON YOUR FIREPLACE

1. Turn the red knob located in the back right of the fireplace so that the knob is parallel to the propane line coming in from the wall.
2. Set REMOTE/OFF/ON switch to "ON".
3. Slightly press in and turn the gas control knob counterclockwise to "Pilot". The knob will not turn without being pressed in.
4. Push the control knob all the way and hold in. While pressing the control knob, repeatedly push the Igniter button until pilot is lit. This can take several minutes. When pilot is lit, hold the gas control button down for 30 seconds. Removing the middle log will allow you to see if the pilot is lit.
5. As you let out the control knob slightly turn counterclockwise to "ON". The fireplace should turn on. This could take up to a minute. If the pilot light goes out, repeat steps 3-5.
6. Once the fireplace is lit, turn the REMOTE/OFF/ON switch to "REMOTE". This will allow you to control the fireplace by the switch on the side wall of the fireplace.

***A Carbon Monoxide Detector should be installed in your home if you are using the gas fireplace. Please be advised that this is an unvented fireplace.*

***The fireplace in your home is not intended to be used as a heat source. It is only for ambience.*

If you have difficulty lighting your fireplace, you will need to call a service vendor.
