We had a very busy 2019 with the roof work and repair that amounted to \$22,500. We are a more than five acre campus and there will always be something to do. We are in the process of doing coping in the pool so as not to allow water to get behind the tiles and concrete. It will be finished prior to the opening of the pool this Spring. We have had a number of water and/or sprinkler repairs this past year amounting to around \$50,000.

Since the inception of Beaucatcher House we have had only four increases in association dues. This year will be the fifth increase of five per cent per condominium and will begin March 1<sup>st</sup>. The Board feels that we will need to increase every year simply to keep up with the cost of living and to maintain a healthy reserve fund. This will help to ensure the integrity of the building and our investment.
